

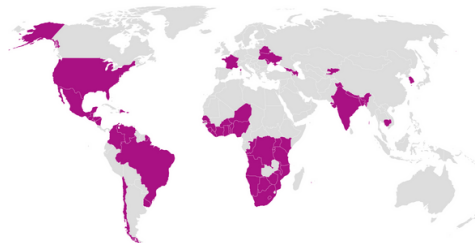

Composed by 15 members elected
by the International Congress.
Meets annually.



Executive Committee

Sub-committee of the International
Council. Meets quarterly.

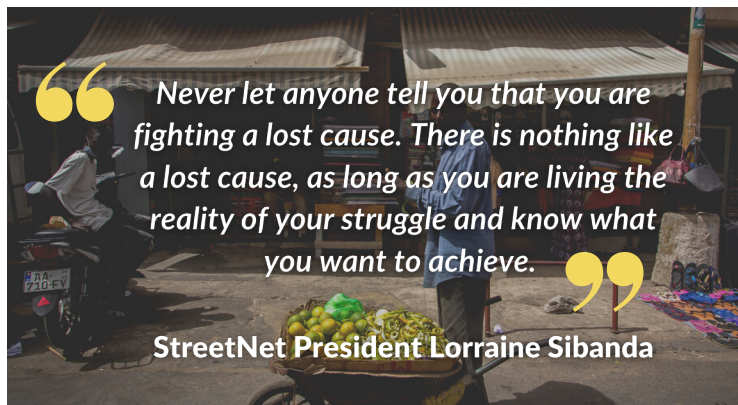
